### Directions from Colorado Springs:

#### Shortest Route:

(70 miles, drive time - 1 hr, 30 min)

From the intersection of CO 115 and Academy Blvd, take CO 115 south to Florence and CO 67. Turn left (south) on CO 67 to Wetmore and CO 96. Turn right (west) on CO 96 to Westcliffe. In Westcliffe, CO 96 becomes Main Street. The school is on the north (right) side of the street at 706 Main Street. There are parking lots on both the east and west sides of the school. Park in the west lot (drive past the school buildings).

#### Easiest Route:

(90 miles, drive time - 1 hr, 35 min)

From the intersection of I-25 and Academy Blvd, take I-25 south to Pueblo and CO 96. Take Exit 99A. Because of one-way streets, the exit will put you on 6th Street going west. You can follow the signs to CO 96 (which is 4th Street here), or turn left (south) onto Santa Fe Ave at the first light and go 2 blocks to 4th Street. In either case, turn right (west) onto 4th Street (CO 96). Follow CO 96 west to Westcliffe. In Westcliffe, CO 96 becomes Main Street. The school is on the north (right) side of the street at 706 Main Street. There are parking lots on both the east and west sides of the school. Park in the west lot (drive past the school buildings).
